State Tax Assistance Program



State Tax Returns

- Situation: Taxpayer requires return from another state which the counselor has not been trained to prepare
- Options:
 - Turn taxpayer away
 - Ignore other state return
 - Rely on TaxSlayer to get it right
 - Get help to complete other state return



State Tax Assistance Program

- Formalized system to obtain assistance from counselors in another state
- Triggered through OneSupport Help Center Ticket System
- Counselors use phone and TaxSlayer



State Tax Assistance Program

- Experienced volunteers provide assistance on their home state tax returns
- Not "instantaneous" second visit for taxpayer necessary to complete returns



Asking for Help...

- Submit a Request through OneSupport
 - Counselor contact info
 - Brief description of taxpayer situation
- Out-of-State "Assisting" Volunteer contacts "Requesting" Counselor
 - Conversation to answer questions
 - Log in to local TaxSlayer account to review return
